Lane assignments and lane movements

Lane draws: Manual before each squad

Athletes per pair in squads: Four

Frequency of movement: After each 2 games

Movement method: Two or four lanes to the right, depending on the number of lanes in use

Ranking and Prize Money, B & C Categories

Bowlers averaging 190 or more (minimum 30 games) are placed in Category A (Open Category). Bowlers averaging 170 – 189.999 are placed in Category B. Bowlers averaging less than 170 are placed in Category C. There will be no finals in the categories B and C. The prize money is guaranteed in both categories as follows:

Position 1: €500

Position 2: €300

Position 3: €200

Position 4: €150

Position 5: €125

Position 6: €100

Bowlers of the categories B and C whose score qualifies them for the Open finals have a choice to either cash out in their category or continue to the finals. The choice must be communicated to the organizers before the start of the Desperado squad.

Finals, Open Category

Sun 20/10 08:30

STEP 1: 32 bowlers – *the top 26 from from the general qualification play, the top 4 from a separate standing from the squads 1–5 (bowled 12–16 October) who are not already qualified among the aforementioned 26 bowlers, and the top 2 bowlers from the one-game Desperado* – shall bowl 4 games at the pace of 4 bowlers per lane pair, carrying over half the score of their high qualification series, changing to the next lane pair on the

right after each game. The top 16 advance to STEP 2. The eliminated bowlers are ranked 17th to 32nd.

STEP 2: The surviving 16 (2 bowlers per lane pair) bowl 4 games, building on the aggregate of the initial carryover and the score from STEP 1, changing to the next lane pair on the right after each game. The top 8 advance to STEP 3. The eliminated bowlers are ranked 9th to 16th.

STEP 3: The surviving 8 (2 bowlers per lane pair) bowl a full round-robin of one-game matches (7 games in all), building on the aggregate of the initial carryover and the score from STEPS 1 and 2, and adding an extra 30 pins for each win and 15 pins for each draw. The winner is the bowler who has highest aggregate score after the last of these 7 games. The rest of the bowlers are ranked 2nd to 8th.
